cavac or crime victims assistance centre, have been created to help victims overcome the physical, psychological and social consequences of a crime, and to advocate on their behalf to help them obtain compensation for the harm suffered.

If you are a victim or witness to a crime then there are three Cree Cavac officers that have been established to serve you in the Cree Nation.


