Two Components

The program, which ranges from 3 to 5 days, is divided into two parts:

- 1. Develop and improve the participants' social skills and self-worth.
- 2. Provide a time of reflection allowing the participant to change their attitude towards school and turn their suspension into a positive experience.

Together, they are aimed at improving the educational and social journey of participants in order to increase the chances of successfully integrating into school environment and society.
